Impact of the Tohoku–Pacific Ocean Earthquake

SECOM extends its deepest sympathy to all those affected by the Tohoku–Pacific Ocean Earthquake, which struck on March 11, 2011.

SECOM continues to assess the full impact of the disaster on the operations of the SECOM Group and today provided the following update.

1. Damage

(a) Personnel

The SECOM Group has been unable to confirm the safety of all Group employees in affected areas. The Group continues to seek information on the whereabouts and safety of those employees not yet accounted for.

(b) Facilities

Damage was sustained by certain SECOM Group facilities. The Group has taken steps to enable the prompt resumption of these facilities' operations, including securing alternative sites. The Group's control centers, the core of its security services operations, continue to operate normally and provide on-line monitoring of security systems installed at customers' premises. At present, however, it is impossible to provide on-line monitoring to certain customers as a consequence of infrastructure and facility damage caused by the quake and the subsequent tsunami. The SECOM Group is devoting its best efforts to restoring normal services to all customers as soon as possible.

2. Impact on Financial Performance

SECOM is presently evaluating the impact of the earthquake on its operating results for the current fiscal year. Should it be determined that the impact is substantial, SECOM will promptly announce revised operating results forecasts.

3. Assistance to Affected Areas

The SECOM Group is helping to provide humanitarian aid in affected areas. In light of deteriorating sanitary conditions, the Group has donated masks and hand disinfectant. The Group has also dispatched a special medical team comprising professionals from Group-affiliated hospitals to help provide vital health care services.

Going forward, the SECOM Group will continue doing its utmost to actively assist relief and recovery efforts.
